STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Carrying Capacity of Certain Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 54, amended. The 3rd paragraph from the end of section 54 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 175 of the public laws of 1935, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'In computation of fees for a combination of truck tractor and semitrailer, the vehicle to be registered for carrying capacity shall be the semitrailer which shall take the same rating as a truck of similar capacity; provided, however, that no motor vehicle of either a single unit or combined unit shall be operated on the highway with a load that exceeds 36,000 40,000 pounds, gross weight of vehicle and load. Truck tractors of a manufacturer's rated capacity of 3 tons used for the sole purpose of hauling or conveying semi-trailers, shall pay an annual registration fee of \$10. Truck tractors of a manufacturer's rated capacity of over 3 tons, used for the sole purpose of hauling or conveying semi-trailers, shall pay an annual registration fee of \$15.'
