### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Authorize the State Forest Commissioner to Sell Certain Real Estate.

Forest commissioner authorized to sell certain real estate. Resolved: That the state forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to sell at private sale, any pieces of real estate which have been transferred to the state by persons receiving aid at the expense of the state, in consideration thereof; and he is further authorized to execute and deliver in the name of the state of Maine such deed or deeds as may be necessary to convey the title to such real estate.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

It occasionally happens that a person receiving assistance as a state pauper owns a home or some other real estate and is willing to turn same over to the state in consideration of the assistance furnished by the state. The state now owns I or more small pieces of real estate which was acquired in this way and it would be helpful if a method could be provided of disposing of such property.
