STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Reckless Driving.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 86, amended. Section 86 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 86. Reckless driving; penalty. Whoever operates any vehicle upon any way, or in any place to which the public has a right of access, operates any vehicle (a) recklessly; or (b) in a manner so as to endanger any person or property shall be guilty of reckless driving and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$200, or by imprisonment for a term of not more than 3 months, or by both such fine and imprisonment; and whoever is convicted the 2nd time for a violation of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$200 and not more than \$500, or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.'
