STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Exemptions of Motor Trucks from Registration.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 57-A, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 57-A, of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Provided, however, that this privilege shall not be granted to motor trucks of a rated earrying capacity of more than 3 tons; and Provided, further, that motor trucks having a rated carrying capacity of 1½ tons or less shall be subject to such exemption from registration as is provided for in section 40.'
