IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Outdoor Advertising.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1935, c. 163, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 163 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby repealed and the following is hereby enacted in place thereof.

'Sec. 3. Fees. Every person, firm or corporation erecting or maintaining any outdoor advertising structure, device or display upon property not occupied by such person, firm or corporation as a place for carrying on the business advertised by such structures, devices or displays shall pay a fee of five cents per square foot for each square foot of each structure, device or display, said fees to be paid annually in advance, and said fee of 5c per square foot to be paid for each side of such structures, devices or displays upon which advertising appears.'
