STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Payment of Personal Property Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Operators' licenses issued only when personal property tax is paid. No license to operate a motor vehicle shall be issued to any person, subject to a personal property tax in this state, until he has paid such tax.

Receipts for the payment of such tax shall be in the form prescribed by the secretary of state. They shall be issued in duplicate, and I copy shall be delivered to the secretary of state at the time application is made to operate a motor vehicle and filed with the application.
