STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Providing for Rights of Riparian Owners in Their Property Below High Water Mark.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The owners of salt water shore property having adjoining flats to mean low water mark shall have the right to regulate and control without license or licenses the use, occupation and cultivation of clams, quahaugs and all other shell-fish on or in said flats so deeded with the same rights to protect their interests and property rights thereto as is accorded them by laws pertaining to upland property, provided, however, that no such riparian owner or owners shall in any way obstruct navigation.
