STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 268, § 13, amended. Section 13 of chapter 268 of the public laws of 1933, as amended by section 3 of chapter 79 of the public laws of 1935, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 13. Retail license fees. The fee for licenses for each hotel, restaurant and club shall be \$100 \$200 per annum; for other retailers not authorized to sell for consumption on the premises \$50 \$100 per annum, for each place to which licenses apply; providing that the state licensing board is authorized to fix the license fee for summer hotels, clubs and restaurants from \$25 \$50 to \$100 \$200, depending upon the size of said summer hotels, clubs and restaurants, and their volume of business.'
