AN ACT Relating to Business Hours for State Stores.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1935, c. 300, § 9, amended. Section 9 of chapter 300 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 9. Business hours for state stores. State stores shall not be open on Sundays, court holidays or on the day of the holding of a general election or state-wide primary or between the hours of 7 10 P. M. and 9 A. M. ~~except on Saturdays when, if open, they may be kept open until 10 P. M.~~ No sales shall be made therein to minors or persons under the influence of liquor.'
