STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to All Railroads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 64, § 96, amended. Section 96 of chapter 64 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 96. Applicable to all railroads. Except where otherwise herein expressly specified sections 88 to ninety eight through 95 and section 97, as amended shall apply only to all railroads operated in whole or principally by steam, electric diesel-electric, diesel-motor, gasoline-electric or gasoline motor power and engaged in the transportation of freight or passengers in standard railroad freight or passenger cars.'
