STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Town Ordinances.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 5, § 136, ¶ VIII amended. Paragraph VIII of section 136 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'VIII. Respecting the erection of buildings or structures therein, and defining their proportions, dimensions, and the material to be used in the construction thereof; and any building erected contrary to a by-law or ordinance adopted under this specification is a nuisance.'
