STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Outdoor Advertising.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1935, c. 163, § 11, amended. Section 11 of chapter 163 of the public laws of 1935 is amended by adding at the end thereof, the following:

'as used herein the compact or built-up section of any town, city or village shall be the territory of any city, town or village contiguous to any way which is built up with structures devoted to business or where the dwelling houses are situated less than 300 feet apart for a distance of at least $\frac{1}{4}$ mile.'
