STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Holders of Malt Liquor Manufacturing Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Malt liquor manufacturing licenses, regulated. No officer, director, or stockholder of a corporation who is the holder of a manufacturer's certificate of approval from the state of Maine, shall in any way be interested, either directly or indirectly, as a director, officer, or stockholder in any other corporation who is the holder of a wholesale license for the sale of malt liquors, granted by the state of Maine. Nor shall a manufacturer or holder of a certificate of approval either directly or indirectly lend any money, credit, or equivalent thereof to any wholesaler in equipping, fitting out, maintaining, or conducting, either in whole or in part, an establishment of business where malt liquors are sold, excepting only the usual and customary commercial credit of malt liquor sold and delivered.
