# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

## AN ACT Relating to Teachers' Pensions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Pensions for teachers. Every teacher who has taught continuously in the public schools of Maine, for more than 40 years, and who has reached the age of 70 years, shall, upon retirement, receive an annual pension of \$900 per year, payable in quarterly installments, in the method now prescribed by the laws relating to teachers' pensions.
