STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Municipal Court of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Salary of recorder increased. Section I of chapter 274 of the private and special laws of 1887, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof.

'Sec. 1. Salary of recorder. The salary of the recorder of the municipal court for the city of Portland shall be \$1600 which shall be in full for all services, and it shall be the duty of said recorder to make and present all copies of libels and monitions in liquor cases.'
