STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, for the Construction of Bunters Along Austin Stream.

Protecting property owners. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$5,000, for the erection of bunters and otherwise protecting the property of owners of land bordering Austin stream in Bingham, along the southerly and easterly shores thereof, between the cement bridge on the Quebec highway and the Kennebec river; said sum to be taken from the general highway fund and expended for said purposes by the state highway commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The waters of Austin stream are washing away the land of adjoining owners.
