STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Recorders of Municipal Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Additional duties of recorders. In the event of the death or resignation or any vacancy of a judge of a municipal court, the recorder shall, as acting judge, receive the salary of the judge in lieu of salary as recorder and shall further be paid for such clerk hire as shall be necessary on account of the additional duties.
