STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge and Recorder of Westbrook Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1909, c. 282, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 282 of the private and special laws of 1909 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- **'Sec. 2. Salary of judge.** The judge of said court shall receive a salary of one thousand dollars \$1500 per year, to be paid to him in quarterly payments from the county treasury of the county of Cumberland, which shall be in full for all his services as judge. All blanks, civil and criminal dockets and record books required by said court shall be furnished by the county of Cumberland.'
- Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1917, c. 176, amended. Chapter 176 of the private and special laws of 1917 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Salary of recorder increased. Such recorder shall receive an annual salary of three hundred dollars \$500, in full for all services as such recorder, which salary shall be paid to him in quarterly payments from the county treasury of the county of Cumberland.'
