AN ACT Relating to Operation of Pari Mutuel Pools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1935, c. 130, § 22, amended. Section 22 of chapter 130 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 22. Supervision. Said commission shall have the power and authority to regulate, supervise and check the making of pari mutuel pools and the distribution therefrom. Said commission shall have the further power and authority to investigate as to the direct and indirect ownership and control of any licensee and any expense incurred by the commission in so doing shall be at the expense of such licensee or of the applicant for a license. **The commission shall not allow or permit any person, firm, association or corporation except residents of Maine to operate pari mutuel pools.'**
