AN ACT Relating to Revocation of Fish and Game Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 43, amended. Section 43 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Sec. 43. Hunting and fishing licenses; revocation of. The commissioner shall revoke the license to hunt and/or fish of any person convicted of a violation of the fish and game laws, or rules and regulations of the commissioner and shall refuse to issue a license to said person for periods as set forth herein; upon the 1st conviction for a period of 6 months, on the 2nd conviction for a period of 18 months, for the 3rd conviction for a period of 3 years, for the 4th conviction for a period of 5 years and on the 5th conviction for a period of 5 years. No license shall be issued to any person after the 5th conviction except after a hearing before the commissioner.’
