AN ACT Relating to Mileage Compensation for County Officials.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Expenses of officials receiving remuneration from counties, regulated.
No person holding any official position in a county, either as head of a department or as an employee of any county shall be entitled to receive mileage for travel by him on official business except for such travel in a motor vehicle or other conveyance owned or controlled by him, and in the event that 2 or more persons travel on official business for any county, mileage shall be paid only to the one person owning or controlling the motor vehicle or other conveyance used in such travel; provided, however, that such persons shall be reimbursed for actual expense incurred by them when traveling on any railroad, public automobile, ferry or other public transportation facility.
