**RESOLVE, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for
Beatrice E. Gilbert, of Bar Harbor.**

Resolves, 1931, c. 98, repealed. Resolved: That that part of chapter 98 of the resolves of 1931, which provides for a state pension for Beatrice E. Gilbert, of Bar Harbor be, and hereby is, repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Beatrice E. Gilbert was granted a state pension of \$20 per month on account of the service of her husband, Henry H. Gilbert, in the world war. On December 25, 1936, Beatrice E. Gilbert married and moved out of the state of Maine.
