RESOLVE, in Favor of Megunticook Lake Anglers' Club.

Megunticook Lake Anglers' Club; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$355.75 to be paid to the Megunticook Lake Anglers' Club, of Camden, being ½ of the amount paid for materials and repair in the construction of the fish screen located in Canaan lake, also known as Megunticook lake. Said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In consideration of the public interest of this club through voluntary contributions, the request is made for an appropriation covering ½ of the actual cost of screen construction including all materials and labor. The money thus appropriated will be spent for further conservation and stocking of these waters, and maintenance of this state screen.
