STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Magallaway Plantation for Building a Fish Screen on Pond Brook.

Appropriation for fish screen in Magallaway Plantation. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appointed, the sum of \$400 to compensate Magallaway Plantation for the building of a fish screen on Pond brook in Magallaway Plantation, provided, however, that some responsible person, corporation, or incorporated fish and game club, or the town in which the outlet of the waters above mentioned are situated, or some other town in the county of Oxford, in which said waters are situated, shall have agreed to assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of the water through the same.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This screen was built by the plantation on recommendation of the department of inland fisheries and game.
