STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Relating to the Digging of Clams in Milbridge.

Making it lawful to dig and take clams in Milbridge. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation that it shall be lawful for the citizens of the town of Milbridge to dig and take clams for any purpose in the clam flats located in the town of Milbridge; notwithstanding any action taken by the municipal officers of said town under section 43 of chapter 2 of the public laws of 1933.
