RESOLVE, in Favor of E. O. Brown, of Vassalboro.

E. O. Brown; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$50 to be paid to E. O. Brown, of Vassalboro, as a full and final settlement against the state for damage by deer to his 24-acre bean patch; said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Deer trampled the bean fields of Mr. Brown, ruining the crops to the extent of \$50.
