RESOLVE, Relative to Fur-bearing Animals on Plymouth Pond.

Hunting and trapping of fur-bearing animals; regulated. Resolved:
That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting the hunting and trapping of fur-bearing animals on Plymouth Pond, in the towns of Plymouth and Etna, county of Penobscot, from Knights and Allen Bridges to Plymouth Dam and as far back as the fish screen between Round Pond and Plymouth Pond.
