RESOLVE, in Favor of Prince H. Thomas, of Masardis.

Prince H. Thomas, compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$50 to be paid to Prince H. Thomas, of Masardis, to compensate him for damages done to his hunting camp by bear or bears; said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Bear or bears completely ruined the roof of one of Mr. Thomas' camps, and wrecked an 18 ft. White canoe. Harold Weeks, fire warden and Donat H. Franck, game warden can both verify as to the damage.
