STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Olin L. Jordan, of Aurora.

Olin L. Jordan; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$50 to be paid to Olin L. Jordan, of Aurora, this amount is to act as a settlement in full for all claims against the state for damages to his blueberries by bears; said sum to be paid from the funds of the inland fisheries and game department.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Upon finding that his blueberries were being destroyed, Mr. Jordan killed a bear and wounded another on his blueberry land and called the game warden. The warden admitted that damage had been done and reported the same to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game.
