#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Mrs. Gilbert Grant, of Columbia Falls.

Mrs. Gilbert Grant; compensated. Resolved. That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$43.75 to be paid to Mrs. Gilbert Grant, of Columbia Falls, as a full and final settlement against the state for damage to her blueberry field by bears; said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Grant has no other income except from her blueberries which were destroyed by bears this past season.
