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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Fred Johnson, of Mt. Chase Plantation.**

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**Fred Johnson; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$20 to be paid to Fred Johnson, of Mt. Chase Plantation, to compensate him for damage done to his bee-hives, bees and honey by bears; said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Two standard Hoffman bee-hives complete with 32 pound box supers containing a good strong colony of bees in each hive valued each at \$10.00, and honey at the estimated value of \$2.00 each were destroyed by bears.
