RESOLVE, in Favor of William A. Moran, of Oxbow.

William A. Moran; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of William A. Moran, of Oxbow, the sum of \$26.30 as a full and final settlement against the state, for damage to his camp No. 4 by a bear; to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On or about September 15, 1936, a bear tore the tar paper off the cook camp in places, and carried off and destroyed supplies.
