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**RESOLVE, in Favor of William A. Moran, of Oxbow.**

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**William A. Moran; compensated.. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of William A. Moran, of Oxbow, the sum of \$25.48 as a full and final settlement against the state, for damage to his camp No. 2 by bears; to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

On or about August 18, 1936, bears destroyed some summer camps located at No. 2 camp owned by Mr. Moran.
