STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the City of Hallowell.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Certain authority granted. The city of Hallowell, or its assigns, is hereby authorized to establish at the muster field, so-called, in the city of Hallowell, an overpass or underpass for passengers or vehicles over or under the tracks of the Maine Central Railroad to afford access to property owned by said city on both sides of the tracks of the said Maine Central Railroad, and in addition to install a pipe line through concrete conduits under the tracks of the Maine Central Railroad for the purpose of holding pipe lines for the conducting of petroleum products, or similar products, or by-products thereof.

Sec. 2. Construction to meet requirements of public utilities commission. All necessary construction to accomplish the above to be done to meet with the requirements of the public utilities commission.
