RESOLVE, Compensating a Bidder on the General Howard Memorial.

Victor Kahill; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$300 to be paid to Victor Kahill, of Portland, to compensate him in full for all claims against the state for expenses, labor and materials used in the making of a model for use in bidding on the General Howard Memorial; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Kahill was asked to make a model to be submitted in the bidding on the General Howard Memorial. He, therefore, produced a three-foot model after much research work, including a trip to Gettysburg to study the location on which the statue would be erected.
