RESOLVE, in Favor of Harold L. Wentworth of Cornish, Maine

Harold L. Wentworth; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of Harold L. Wentworth, of Cornish, the sum of \$37.73 as a full and final settlement for claims against the state for damage to his car by deer; to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The accident happened on July 9, 1935, while driving through the village of Alfred. The deer jumped over stone wall directly in front of car, and collision was unavoidable, causing considerable damage to radiator and mudguard. Reported and investigated by Warden Geo. Clayton.
