STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Outdoor Advertising.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1935, c. 163, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 163 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Fees. The fees for such permits shall be \$ at the rate of 2 cents per square foot of for each panel, bulletin or sign payable annually in advance, except that the fee for such panel, bulletin or sign as shall be required to be relocated as elsewhere provided in this act shall not be payable until so relocated, provided however that no such permit shall be issued for less than \$. A fee shall be paid for each side of each panel, bulletin or sign of a series shall require a permit and the payment of a separate permit fee, the aforesaid fees to be in lieu of all other taxes upon each panel, bulletin or sign. All fees for such permits shall be payable annually in advance.'
