STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Arthur Liberty, of North Yarmouth.

Arthur Liberty; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of Arthur Liberty, of North Yarmouth, the sum of \$60 as a full and final settlement against the state, for damage to his car by deer; said sum to be paid from the funds of the inland fisheries and game department.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The accident happened around 12 o'clock at night while driving along route 115 between Gray and Yarmouth. It was absolutely unavoidable. This accident was reported and the bill was given to Warden Adams of Gray.
