Senate Amendment E to Consolidated Bill "A" H. P. 1884, L. D. 1058, entitled: "An Act to Provide for Old Age Assistance, to Guarantee a Minimum Educational Program and to Provide Revenues Therefor by Means of Miscellaneous Taxes."

Amend section 26 of Title VI of said bill by striking out everything after the head note in said section and inserting in place thereof the following:

'No tax shall be levied or collected upon any admissions charged at any place of amusement operated solely for the benefit of any religious organization where the proceeds of such admissions do not inure to any one or more individuals; nor shall such tax apply to admissions charged at any athletic games or contests between high schools or grammar schools; nor to admissions to county, state or community fairs.'
