STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the State Racing Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. L., 1935, c. 130, § 8, amended. Section 8 of chapter 130 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 8. Disbursements. The compensation of the commissioners, expenses of the commissioners, compensation of assistants and other necessary expenses of the commission, including suitable furniture, equipment, supplies and office expenses shall be charged to and paid out of the fund received under the provisions of this act, but in no one year shall the total compensation and expenses aforesaid exceed \$12,000.'
