STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Appropriating Money for the Maintenance, Supervision and Use of State Parks.

Maintenance of park areas; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$7,500 for the fiscal year 1937-1938, and \$7,500 for the fiscal year 1938-1939, to be expended under the direction of the governor and council for the maintenance, supervision and use of the park areas under the jurisdiction of the state park commission, if and when, upon the approval of the governor and council, said park areas shall be conveyed to the state of Maine by the United States government, or other park areas that may be acquired by said commission.
