**AN ACT Providing for the Reduction in Fees for Registration of Motor
Vehicles.**

Whereas, a reduction of fees for registration of motor vehicles is possible and expedient, and the enactment of the following provisions would be of great assistance to the people of this state, and

Whereas, in order to make the provisions of this act effective to all registrants of motor vehicles in 1938, it is necessary that this act become immediately effective, and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section 16 of Article XXXI of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, now, therefore

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. Automobile registration fees reduced. After the effective date of this act, the secretary of state when collecting any fees in excess of \$2 for the registration of motor vehicles as fixed and established by the revised statutes as amended, is authorized and directed to reduce said fees so fixed and established by an amount equal to 5% thereof, and all provisions of the revised statutes as amended so fixing and establishing such fees in excess of said \$2 are hereby amended in accordance herewith.

Sec. 2. Emergency clause. In view of the emergency set forth in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
