STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Temporary Licenses for Physicians and Surgeons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 21, § 12, amended. Section 12 of chapter 21 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'Temporary licenses allowing emergency practice for a period not longer than 8 weeks may be granted to applicants who fulfil all requirements and are fully approved by the board, the fee to be \$25; provided that neither the board nor the secretary thereof shall have power to issue more than I temporary permit to any I person nor to extend any such permit beyond the time herein limited.'
