STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to Hunting and Fishing Licenses; Revocation of.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 43, amended. Section 43 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sc. 43. Hunting and fishing licenses; revocation of. Upon the conviction of any person holding a license issued by virtue of this chapter for a violation of any provision of this chapter or rules and regulations of the commissioner, the commissioner shall revoke the license of said person and no new license shall be issued to him for a period of 6 months thereafter. The commissioner may, after a hearing, revoke or refuse to issue any such license for an additional period not to exceed 2 years, and no license shall be issued to said person for a like period. Any person whose license has been revoked shall, within 48 hours after notice thereof, return said license to the commissioner. The commissioner may refuse to issue any license provided for by this chapter for a like period and in the same manner as set forth above, after a conviction for any violation of the fish and game laws by a person not holding a proper license at the time of such violation.'
