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**RESOLVE, Relating to Boothbay Harbor-Southport Bridge.**

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**Resolved:** that there be, and hereby is appropriated from the state bridge fund, in favor of the county of Lincoln and the towns of Boothbay Harbor and Southport, the amounts that their share in the cost of building the Boothbay Harbor-Southport bridge exceeds 20% for the county of Lincoln and 10% for each town.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Boothbay Harbor-Southport bridge must be rebuilt in the immediate future. This is a bridge over tidewater connecting the town of Boothbay Harbor with the town of Southport and will require expensive construction and a draw will be required as there is an excessive depth of water.
