**RESOLVE, Relating to State Highway in Boothbay, Boothbay Harbor
and Southport.**

Designation of state highway in Boothbay, etc. Resolved: That the state highway commission be, and hereby is, directed to designate as a state highway that part of the state aid road in the towns of Boothbay, Boothbay Harbor and Southport, beginning at route 27 in the town of Boothbay near the soldiers' monument, thence westerly and southerly via West Harbor Pond to intersect route 27 at West Boothbay Harbor; thence following route 27 to and through the town of Southport to Newagen Inn postoffice via West Southport.
