AN ACT Relative to Game Preserve in Washington and Hancock Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 90, amended. Section 90 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding before the 6th paragraph from the end thereof the following:

‘Beddington game preserve. No person shall at any time, hunt, pursue, shoot at, or kill any wild animal or any game or wild bird within the following described territory in Washington and Hancock counties; within 100 yards either side of the center of the CCC road (so-called) in the town of Beddington and township 29 in Washington county and township 34, 33 and 32 in Hancock county, beginning at the junction of said CCC road with the Airline road (so-called) in the town of Beddington and ending at the junction of said CCC road with the highway at Myra in township 32.’
