STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT to Promote Aviation in Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. The governor, with the advice and consent of the council, is hereby authorized to appoint a committee of 3, all residents of Maine, to serve during the pleasure of the governor and council.

Sec. 2. The said committee shall receive neither compensation for their services nor expenses incurred during their term of office.

Sec. 3. The sole duty of the committee shall be to study aeronautical conditions of the state of Maine and to make recommendations to the secretary of state, and to the governor and council for the improvement of the same.

Sec. 4. The committee, the secretary of state, and the governor and council, for the purpose of improving aeronautical conditions in the state of Maine, are hereby authorized to co-operate with and co-ordinate with such other agencies, whether state or federal, as may be working toward the development of aeronautics within the state of Maine.

Sec. 5. The committee shall be known as "The Aeronautical Committee".
