AN ACT Authorizing Peabody Law School to Confer Degrees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Peabody Law School, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Maine and having its principal place of business at Portland in the county of Cumberland, shall have full power and authority to confer such degrees in law as are usually conferred by universities and law schools established for the education of youth.
