S T A T E O F M A I N E

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

**AN ACT to Ratify and Make Valid the Incorporation of the Maine State
Advent Christian Conference.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Incorporation of Maine State Advent Christian Conference ratified and made valid. The incorporation of Maine State Advent Christian Conference in Biddeford, county of York, as attempted in 1910, in accordance with the provisions of the statutes of Maine in such case made and provided, under the name and title of Maine State Advent Christian Conference; is hereby ratified, affirmed and made valid, and all acts and doings of its members and officers acting as a body corporate and politic hereby are declared to be of the same full, complete and binding force and effect as such acts and doings would have been had the incorporation so attempted been wholly accomplished on the 11th day of November, 1910.

Sec. 2. Conveyances and other instruments in writing made valid and binding. All conveyances, transfers and other documents and instruments in writing heretofore executed by the officers of said organization as a body corporate for and in the name of Maine State Advent Christian Conference are hereby declared to be valid and binding on the corporation. All conveyances, grants and transfers of title of property, real and personal,

heretofore made to said Maine State Advent Christian Conference, as a corporation, are hereby declared to have the same force and effect as such conveyances, grants and transfers would have had, had the incorporation been wholly accomplished on said 11th day of November, 1910.
